### ❖ What to Look For:

There are three main touch points that make a good co-hosting situation:

1. Chemistry (As noted above!)
2. Good value (Will they bring good content to the table?)
3. A good work ethic (When it comes to the workload, sharing is caring.)

### ❖ One Approach...

So, you have a person (or a few people) in mind as potential co-hosts? Well, then, how to decide?

1. Invite them on for 2 co-hosting sessions. (They may have nerves the first time.)
2. Don't let them know they are auditioning.
3. Look for the person that meets the three main points to look for noted to the left.
